

ChildFund Australia Fact Sheets - Introduction

As part of the ChildFund Australia Strategic Plan, 2006 – 2011, a commitment was made to try and achieve a deeper understanding of the experience of children in the beneficiary communities served by ChildFund.

To help achieve this understanding, a learning and development project was undertaken to provide all staff in the organisation with foundation level knowledge on core topics. Six areas of knowledge were identified and cross-organisational working groups developed 'fact sheets' in relation to each topic, using key reference documents.



The fact sheets are aimed at informing all ChildFund staff – regardless of their position in the organisation - on core areas of knowledge concerning children and development. The materials are also used to inform and educate donors, sponsors and other stakeholders.
