Your gift options

There are a number of different gifts you can consider in your will. Please ensure that you seek legal and financial advice when making your will.

Residue of your estate

This is the remainder of your estate after all debts have been paid and assets or amounts have been distributed to your family and friends.

This gift allows your donation to be used for whatever is most needed at the time – for example, if a donation was received during a drought in Africa the funds could be used immediately to provide water, food or healthcare.

Suggested wording:

After the foregoing provisions of my will for my family and friends have been carried out, I give the rest and residue of whatever kind of my estate remaining to ChildFund Australia (ABN 79 002 885 761) registered office Level 8, 162 Goulburn Street, Surry Hills NSW 2010 for its general purposes and declare that the receipt of an executive officer at the time shall be sufficient discharge of my executor's duty.

A percentage or specific gift

This is any percentage, specific sum of money, property, shares or anything of value you choose to leave. You can share your estate among several people or organisations.

Suggested wording:

I give and bequeath (___ per cent of my estate or, the sum of \$____, or ____ item), free of all duties and testamentary expenses, to ChildFund Australia (ABN 79 002 885 761) registered office Level 8, 162 Goulburn Street, Surry Hills NSW 2010 for its general purposes and declare that the receipt of an executive officer at the time shall be sufficient discharge of my executor's duty.
